






**3 DAYS OF PRAYER** August 21-23

Deeper Christian Unity | More Power of the Holy Spirit | Renewed Passion to Share our Faith This fall, churches all around the country will join together for 3 days, of prayer, we want to unite together and pray for a renewed passion to share our faith, for more power from the Holy Spirit and for deeper unity in our churches and across our communities so that the world may believe. There are two ways you can get involved:

Joining us on **Wednesday night at 7PM** for 1 hour of prayer together, and/or signing up to pray on your own, joining people from all over the country. We are praying for 2,200 people to be mobilized in prayer for 72 hours. We want every moment— every second, covered in prayer. Please join us!



Next weekend we will welcome Fr. Ernest Biriruka to our parish. He will be with us on 8/18 & 8/19 to talk about his mission and to appeal for our help and support. The second collection next weekend will be to support Father Biriuka's mission for the Diocese of Muyinga.

Muyinga is one of the eight Dioceses of Burundi, in Central East of Africa. It is located in the Northern part of the country and has border with Rwanda and Tanzania. About 60% of the territory of Muyinga Diocese are Catholics. Burundi has been impoverished by the 13 year civil war and is now trying to build basic infrastructure.

The Diocese of Muyinga would like to provide a rehab center for the priests and the population in Muyinga. As of now, there is no such facility in the whole town of Muyinga and vicinity. The rehab center is intended primarily for elderly and sick priests. The projected budget is about 60,000 dollars: by American standards that would not be enough, but by Burundian standards that would be OK to have the building. His Excellency Joachim Ntahondereye, the Bishop of Muyinga Diocese delegatedme, Father Ernest Biriruka, to conduct this mission of fund raising, the kindest permission of His Excellency, the Most Reverend Thom-

as Wenski Archbishop of Miami. Bishop Ntahondereye and I, are very grateful for your generosity towards the people and the priests of Muyinga.

**Did you know...** that stained glass windows were used to beautify buildings, control light and often times to tell a story? Many believe that the stained glass was first created by ancient Egyptians. Our beautiful Blessed Trinity is no exception, the stain glass windows on the sides of the church add beauty and display religious symbols and saints.

On one side of our Church we have Mary, Immaculate Conception, the next window shows a Lilly symbolizing St.. Joseph, St. Martin De Porres, the next window has a staff with a stole symbolizing Holy Orders, the next one is St. Francis of Assis, the next window is the symbol for Confirmation, followed by St. Paul, the Eucharist and the last window is the Annunciation.
