
Beat the heat ... Have some fun. Come to SAAM!

## **Baptisms / Bautizos**

ENGLISH: First Sunday of every month @ 2PM

**Communion and Confirmation** require 2 years of preparation in order to receive the Sacrament.

*La Primera Comunión y Confirmación requieren 2 años de preparación para recibir el sacramento.*

**Holy Matrimony** - A date cannot be set until all requirements are met. You should schedule to meet with a priest at least 8—10 months prior to expected wedding date.

*No se puede establecer una fecha hasta que se cumplan todos los requisitos. Uted debe hacer cita con un sacerdote por lo menos 8- 10 meses antes de su boda.*

## **Anointing of the Sick / Unción de los enfermos**

Anyone who is ill, anticipating surgery, or undergoing medical testing is encouraged to receive the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick.

## **To the Parents of young children, may we suggest....RELAX!**

God put the wiggle in the children, don't feel you have to suppress it in God's house, all are welcomed! Sit towards the front where it is easier for your little ones to see and hear what is going on at the altar. They tire of seeing the backs of others! Quietly explain the parts of the Mass and actions of the priest, choir, and other ministries. Help them find the hymns and prayers in the hymnal or booklets. Sing the hymns, participate in the liturgy and pray. Children learn about worship and liturgical behavior by copying you. If you have to leave Mass with your child, feel free to do so, **but please come back!** As Jesus said, "Let the children come to me..." Remember that the way we welcome children in church directly affects the way they respond to the church, to God and to one another. Let them know that they are at home in His house of worship.




