## Servants of the Pierced Hearts of Jesus and Mary



Dear Blessed Trinity family:

We thank the Lord that in His designs of mercy, He wanted to give us a convent at this parish where we have found a family that opened its doors and welcomed us with so much love.

Time has passed so quickly! It has been eleven years since Fr. Carney, wanting to have the presence of religious life in the parish, offered our Mother Foundress, Mother Adela Galindo, the convent that had been occupied by the sisters who had served in the school and the parish before.

It was during the month of March of 2008, that the first sisters arrived to live in the convent that our Mother Foundress named under the patronage of "Saint Joseph". What began only as the "presence of religious in the parish," expanded when the doors for working at the school and the some ministries of the parish began to open. Over the years, there have been several sisters who have passed through this convent, some serving in a mission in the school and others only in residence, since their missions were in other parishes. Nevertheless, each and every one of us holds a deep gratitude towards this community which our Lord called us to serve with our Marian Charism. Each sister has always held and will continue to hold in our daily prayer the intentions and needs of this parish.

This weekend, we would like to share with you some news regarding us and a new convent where we will begin to reside very soon. The family of a young woman who recently joined our community donated a house to us which is five minutes away from our Mother House and halfway between the parishes where the sisters who are currently living here serve, Sr. Evelyn here at Blessed Trinity, Sr. Michelle and I at St. Agnes. This new convent will be named, "Saint Margaret Mary." God willing, we will be moving in very soon.

We want to share with you that the care that "St. Joseph" has had over us during these 11 years has been remarkable. We recognize and appreciate the "Josephite" hearts of Fr. "Joseph" Carney, and currently of Fr. "Jose" Alfaro, both of whom have always been very attentive to provide for our community. Saint Joseph took care of Jesus and Mary in Nazareth, and here in Miami Springs, he raised up two priests to care for our community.

The providence of the Lord has been so visible and palpable through all of you, through so many families who with great generosity, warmth, closeness, care and donations have provided for our needs. Thank you from the bottom of our hearts. It is difficult to explain how each donation helped us in such a way that our convent was able to even help the houses of formation of our Institute that continues to grow and which requires so much.

To all of you, thank you very much! Know that you are in our prayers daily.

We ask the Lord to reward you a hundredfold, all the parishioners of Blessed Trinity from whom we have received so much.

Querida familia de Blessed Trinity:

Damos gracias al Señor que en sus designios de misericordia quiso regalarnos un convento en esta parroquia en la cual encontramos una familia que nos abrió sus puertas y nos acogió con tanto amor.

El tiempo ha pasado muy rápido, 11 años desde que Fr. Carney queriendo tener presencia religiosa en la parroquia ofreciera a Nuestra Madre Fundadora, Madre Adela Galindo, el convento que había sido ocupado por las hermanas que habían servido en la escuela y la parroquia con anterioridad.

Fue en el mes de Marzo de 2008 que llegaron las primeras hermanas a habitar el convento que Nuestra Madre nombro bajo el patrocinio de "San José". Queremos compartirles que ha sido notable el cuidado que "San José" ha tenido con nosotras durante estos 11 años: Reconocemos y agradecemos los corazones "josefitas" de Fr. "Joseph" Carney, y ahora de Fr. "José" Alfaro, siempre atentos a proveer por nuestra comunidad. San José cuidó de Jesús y María en Nazaret, y aquí en Miami Springs suscitó a dos sacerdotes que han sido siempre atentos con nuestra comunidad.

La providencia del Señor ha sido tan visible y palpable a través también de todos ustedes, de tantas familias que con tanta generosidad, calidez, cercanía, cuidado y donaciones han provisto por nuestras necesidades. Gracias de todo corazón. Es difícil explicar cómo cada donación nos ayudaba de tal forma que nuestro convento a su vez podía ayudar a las casas de formación de nuestro Instituto que crece y requiere de mucho.
