

Father Alfaro's Midnight Musings

WELCOME WEEKEND

I would like to extend a warm welcome to all of you here today. If this is your first time visiting Blessed Trinity or if you have not been here for a while, I hope that you find a home in our midst.. It is a blessing to have the opportunity to praise and worship together today.

Welcome Weekend is an initiative that came from the Synod that Archbishop Wenski initiated several years ago. An Archdiocesan Synod is a local council formally convened to discuss church affairs. At that Synod, one of the main priorities was for parishes to become centers of hope and evangelization. Every Catholic needs to embrace his/her missionary call from Christ to "Go and make disciples of all nations." This may not be something that we are used to as Catholics, but the reality is that the church is missionary from its inception. Pope Francis has renewed this call by reminding Catholics to go out and bring Christ to others. This is something that we must do every day; it cannot be left to chance. St. John Paul II would state that the task of evangelization "cannot be left to a group of 'specialists' but must involve all the members of the people of God. Those who have come into genuine contact with Christ cannot keep Him for themselves, they must proclaim him." My desire is that Blessed Trinity continues being an invitational church not only this weekend but throughout the entire year.

Did you know... Part I Why do we Catholics, stand, sit and kneel during mass?

To our non-Catholic friends we may come across as maybe a bit anxious or that we simply can't stay still....Not quiet, there is a significant reason for all our postures.



Standing is a common posture for prayers started during the early Christians. We stand out of respect. We sit to listen and to learn. And we kneel as the ultimate surrendering before our God.

When the priest enters and processes towards the altar, we stand in reverence. The priest is in the person of Christ. We continue to stand during the opening prayer, the Penitential Rite and the Gloria. We also stand when the Gospel is read to show reverence and respect to the word of God. We sit to listen to the two readings and the singing of the psalms. This is the time to listen and learn, "what message does God want for me today". We kneel as the ultimate sign of humility before our God, praying and surrendering ourselves to Him.

El Fin de Semana de Bienvenida es una iniciativa que surgió del Sínodo que el Arzobispo Wenski inició hace algunos años. Un Sínodo de la Arquidiócesis es un consejo local convocado formalmente para discutir asuntos eclesiásticos. En ese Sínodo, una de las principales prioridades era que las parroquias se convirtieran en centros de esperanza y evangelización. Cada católico necesita abrazar su llamado misionero de Cristo para "ir y hacer discípulos de todas las Naciones." Esto quizá sea algo a lo que no estemos acostumbrados como católicos, pero la realidad es que la iglesia es misionera desde su fundación. El Papa Francisco ha renovado este llamado al recordarnos que debemos salir afuera y traerle a Cristo a los demás. Esto es algo que debemos hacer todos los días; no se puede dejar al azar. San Juan Pablo II afirmaría que la tarea de evangelización "no se le puede dejar a un grupo de 'especialistas' sino que debe involucrar a todos los miembros del pueblo de Dios. Aquellos que han tenido un encuentro genuino con Cristo no se pueden quedar con Él en sus adentros, deben de proclamarlo." Mi deseo es que Blessed Trinity siga siendo una iglesia acogedora no sólo este fin de semana, sino durante todo el año.
